Reserve Study

New Streetlights

A proposal to add new streetlights to areas behind or between houses that are not well lit at night was not passed as there was concern that the placement of these lights would be a nuisance to residents whose bedrooms would be affected by the lighting.

Action Item

Small solar lights will be placed on the bridge and stairway for safety reasons and the Board will provide motion detector lights for any residents who request them.
