

**Spring Breeze Community Association (SBCA)  
Exterior Paint Colors**



**Introduction:**

This white paper summarizes the exterior paint colors and color combinations permitted for townhouses in Spring Breeze. NOTE: Any changes from the original color or the most recently approved color by the KCCA RAC will require homeowners to submit a RAC exterior alteration application. The only time a RAC application is not required is if there is no change to the most recently approved (by the RAC) color or to the original color of an exterior element of your unit.

However, it is the homeowners’ responsibility to determine what these colors are if you plan to repaint any exterior elements of your unit. The SBCA strongly encourages homeowners to contact the KCCA to determine if a RAC application has ever been submitted and/or approved for your unit. Please pay close attention to the approved list of exterior colors found in this document. Many homes in Spring Breeze have not had color changes in the 30 + years since original construction, and because of this, owners needs to be particularly careful to ensure current color names do in fact match the original paint colors.

Color and color combinations other than those found in this document might be permitted on a case-by-case basis, if the homeowner submits an exterior alteration request to the RAC and obtains approval ([www.kingscontrivancecommunityassociation.org](http://www.kingscontrivancecommunityassociation.org)).

**Colors:**

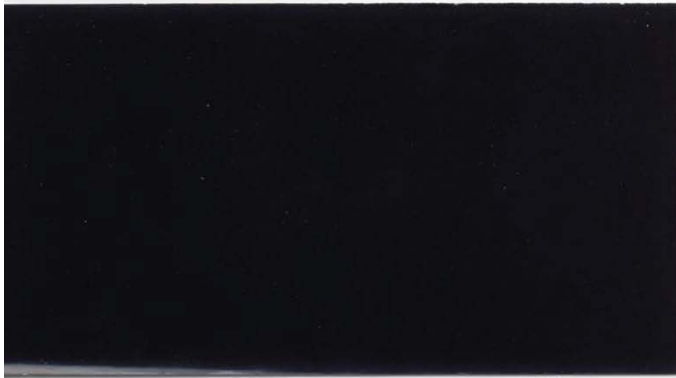
The tables below show color combinations for various parts of the units’ exterior. A homeowner selects a given row, and the colors across that row correspond to the part of the house listed at the top of each column. Where available, the color identification number (‘M’= *McCormick* / ‘D’ = *Duron*) corresponding to each color are provided. **NOTE: Some of the swatches shown in document appear different when viewed on a computer screen version versus a hard copy print out and/or an actual color swatch from the store.** When in doubt, refer to the color identification number. Please have the color identification number available when at the retail store for paint selection and purchase.

*Table 1. These colors are the original colors that were used to paint the homes in Spring Breeze. These names are from the old McCORMICK brand, but they are recognized by Sherwin-Williams and Duron retail stores. Each color is given the original manufacturers identification number. **See figure 4 for color swatches of roof shingles listed** (shingle colors available for order at most home improvement centers).*

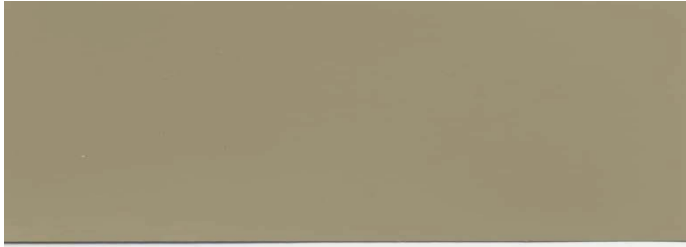

*Both computer screen and hard copy versions appear darker than actual paint swatch from store.*



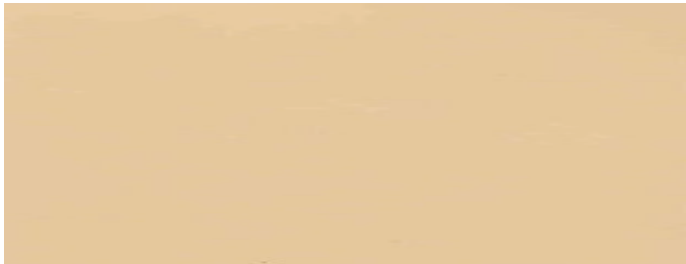
**Cypress** (*M-103 / D-811*)

*Computer screen swatch appears more peach than actual swatch from store. Hard copy version represents color more accurately.*



**Sandstone** (*see note from table 1*)

\*\* Note! Sandstone is the actual color name. Color swatch shown is Duron color ‘Old Brown Mountain’ (*D-8501*), and should **only** be used for reference. Duron has formula for matching to the McCormick color ‘Sandstone’.

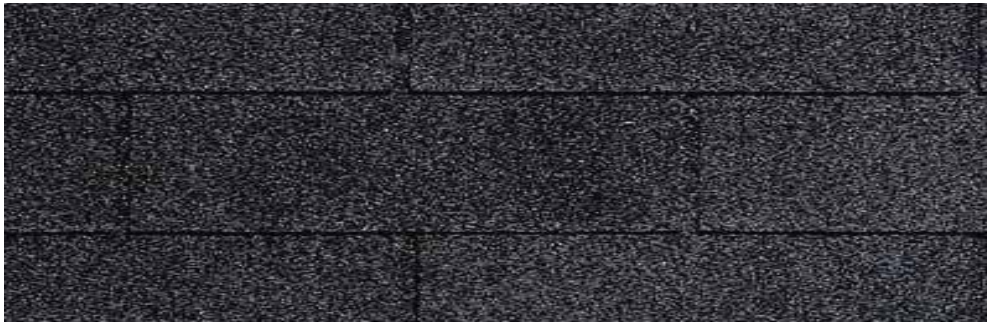

*Table 2. The colors in the above table were approved as additional color combinations sometime after the original units were built. While these color names are from the old DURON brand, they are still recognized by McCormick and Sherwin-Williams and can be matched*
